1. Is the philosophy of the facility supportive of baccalaureate education?	
2. Do the types of clients provide opportunities for learning of specified objectives?	
3. Is the standard of care within the facility reflective of statutory and accrediting requirements?	
4. Is the chief administrator supportive of baccalaureate nursing education?	
5. Are nursing staff in units selected for clinical learning experiences appropriate role models for baccalaureate students?	
6. Does the presence of other students influence or detract meeting the specific clinical objectives?	
7. Are facilities available which enhance pre- and post-clinical activities, such as conference rooms, library, parking, and dining?	
8. Are all contractual terms mutually acceptable to both the University and the cooperating facility?	
9. Is feedback from faculty and students previously assigned to facility favorable?	
10. Is the facility location reasonable in terms of travel in distance to and from the School of Nursing?
