

## General Information

The online Post Professional Master of Science in Occupational Therapy is designed for occupational therapists who have been NBCOT certified at the baccalaureate level. All courses are taught completely online and there are no on-campus requirements. *The Post Professional Master of Science in Occupational Therapy* consists of 30 credits including the master's project. A maximum of six credits of graduate course work may be transferred from other institutions.

The curriculum has two core components. The practice core is designed to further develop the student's skills in utilizing evidence based practice and theory in occupational therapy practice settings. The research core is designed to develop the student's clinical research and writing skills, culminating in the master's project.
