ABOUT THE PROGRAM

The Master of Science in Occupational Therapy (MSOT) at FIU prepares entry-level occupational therapists. This intensive, hands-on program equips students with the tools, knowledge, and skills to promote health, wellness, and functional independence throughout the life span. Graduates of the MSOT program are eligible for certification by the National Board for Certification in Occupational Therapy (NBCOT).

Admissions Minimum Requirements

- **A bachelors degree from an accredited college or university**
- **A GPA of 3.0 in the last 60 hours of upper division undergraduate coursework.**
- **Required cumulative 3.0 GPA for all prerequisite courses.**
- **Prerequisite courses must be taken within 5 years of application.**
- **Complete the following prerequisite courses prior to the start of the fall admission term with a minimum grade of "C":**
 - Biology with Lab
 - Statistics
 - Human Growth & Development
 - Abnormal Psychology
 - Medical Terminology
- **A grade of "B" or above must be earned in the following 4 courses: Applicants with 3 of the 4 courses completed by the application deadline will be given priority for review and potential admission.**
 - Physiology
 - Kinesiology
 - Human Anatomy with Lab
 - Neuroscience (3000 level or higher)
