The Bachelor of Health Services Administration (BHSA) program emphasizes ethical change management, inter-professional collaboration, leadership, informatics and communication so these professionals can manage and shape policy in a fast-changing, fast-paced technological environment.

The courses of the FIU Health Services Administration programs align to prepare students for varying degrees of responsibilities as health services administrators. This includes:

- Planning, directing and coordinating medical and health services
- Create and implementing policy and procedures
- Hiring and supervise staff
- Controlling finances
- Collaborating with other healthcare managers and stakeholders.

Admissions Minimum Requirements

- Completed 60 hours of course work – OR – completed the Associate in Arts (AA) degree or its equivalent – at an accredited college or university.
- Satisfied the general University requirements for admission, including the University's Core Curriculum requirements.
- Met the University's lower division requirements.
- Complete the following BHSA prerequisite** courses as part of their 60 credit-hours of lower-division course work and achieve a minimum "C" required grade in any one course for the following required prerequisites:
 - Principles of Microeconomics
 - Accounting for Decisions
 - Accounting for Planning and Control
 - Introduction to Microcomputers
 - Introduction to Statistics I or
 - Statistics I or High School Algebra
 - Statistics for the Health Professions or
 - Statistics for Business and Economics

**NOTE: Applicants can be in the process of completing the prerequisites when applying to the program; however, all admitted students must complete all prerequisites before taking BHSA courses.

- 1 Apply online at FIU Undergraduate Admissions
 - Send Official Transcripts from all school attended (ASN, AA, BA/BS, etc.) to FIU Office of Undergraduate Admissions
 - Graduates of foreign schools must complete TOEFL exam with 550 or higher
