The Bachelor of Science in Nursing (BSN) program prepares diverse health care professionals as providers and leaders in the delivery of high quality, accessible, culturally competent care within a technological and global environment. The College promotes, expands and validates scientific knowledge and evidence-based practice through interdisciplinary research.

Admissions Minimum Requirements

- 3.00 minimum GPA from a BA/BS degree in another discipline from a regionally accredited institution; FEP's: Doctor of Medicine from an accredited foreign medical school with a minimum 2.00 GPA as shown on a NACES evaluation (visit naces.org for participating companies). Degrees must be completed by the Spring semester of the year in which you apply.
- Applicants must successfully meet all FIU Undergraduate Admissions requirements.
- Successful completion of the ATI TEAS exam with a minimum overall score of 70% and a minimum science score of 62%. To register for the exam, please visit: testing.fiu.edu.
- Minimum cumulative GPA of 3.25 or higher is required for all nursing prerequisite courses. Completion of ALL nursing prerequisite courses by no later than two semesters prior to the corresponding application cycle. Applicants may ONLY have up to two prerequisites in progress at the time application is submitted.
- Science courses must have been taken within the last ten years. One science prerequisite failure (C- or below) is allowed but it must have been successfully repeated for a passing grade. A second science failure will lead to disqualification. All science courses must be completed by the time the application is submitted.

How to Apply:

- 1 Complete FIU Undergraduate Application
 - Apply online to FIU Undergraduate Admissions at admissions.fiu.edu (Service fee)
 - Send official transcripts from all schools attended for college credit (AA, BA/BS, etc.) to FIU Undergraduate Admissions
 - Demonstrate English Proficiency (ONLY Graduates of non-English speaking institutions) by the FIU requirements
 - Ex: iBT TOEFL: 80
 - Paper TOEFL 550/IELTS: 6.5
