The Bachelor of Science in Nursing - Accelerated Option at FIU is uniquely designed for people who hold a bachelor's degree in another field. The U.S. Department of Labor's growth outlook for RN jobs by the year 2024 is more than double the growth rate for all occupations. It's why many are considering a career – or a career change – in nursing.

Graduates of the program are eligible to become licensed as a registered nurse (RN) upon passing the National Council Licensure Examination for Registered Nurses (NCLEX-RN®) and can pursue graduate studies in nursing at the master's and doctoral levels.

Admissions Minimum Requirements

- Bachelor's (BA or BS) degree from a regionally accredited college or university with a minimum Bachelor's Degree GPA of a 3.0. Degree must be completed by no later than the end of the Spring term of the year in which you apply
- Successful completion of ALL prerequisites from a regionally accredited institution in the U.S. by the end of the Spring semester for Fall admission
- Minimum cumulative 3.25 GPA for all prerequisite courses
