The Bachelor of Science in Nursing (BSN) program prepares diverse health care professionals as providers and leaders in the delivery of high quality, accessible, culturally competent care within a technological and global environment. The College promotes, expands and validates scientific knowledge and evidence-based practice through interdisciplinary research.

#### **Admissions Minimum Requirements**

- Associate of Arts (AA) degree or completed a minimum of 54 semester hours; and completion of the FIU core curriculum (UCC).
- Transfer students must successfully meet all FIU Undergraduate Admissions requirements.
- Minimum cumulative GPA of 3.25 from all previous college coursework, including dual enrollment.
- Successful completion of the ATI TEAS exam with a minimum overall score of 70% and a minimum 62% in the science portion. To register, please visit: testing.fiu.edu.
- Completion of ALL nursing prerequisite courses by no later than two semesters
  prior the the corresponding application cycle. Applicants may ONLY have up to two
  prerequisites in progress at the time application is submitted.
- Science courses must have been taken within the last ten years. One science
  prerequisite failure (C- or below) is allowed but it must have been successfully
  repeated for a passing grade. A second science failure will lead to disqualification.
  All science courses must be completed by the time the application is submitted.

## How to Apply:

Complete FIU Undergraduate Application

- Apply online to FIU Undergraduate Admissions at admissions.fiu.edu (Service fee.)
- Send official transcripts from all schools attended for college credit (AA, AS, etc.) to FIU Undergraduate Admissions
- Demonstrate English Proficiency (ONLY Graduates of non-English speaking institutions) by the FIU requirements Ex:
  - iBT TOEFL: 80/Paper TOEFL 550
  - IELTS: 6.5

<u>nursingcas.liaisoncas.org/apply</u> by the appropriate deadline. (Service fee.)

Clinical Placements: Immunizations, drug screening and a criminal history background check are required prior to participation in clinical setting. Clinical facilities may limit or prohibit students with criminal or drug histories from participating in clinical settings. Students must complete all practicum requirements with an approved preceptor and only in settings that have a signed contract with FIU.
