Admissions Minimum Requirements

- Possess a master's degree from a regionally accredited institution with a minimum of 27 graduate level credits+
- Have a minimum cumulative GPA of 3.0 (on a 4.0 scale) in graduate coursework
- Submit proof of athletic training certification through the Board of Certification (or the equivalency for international applicants)
- Submit proof of state credential (if applicable in the student's current state of residence/practice)
- Have 2-3 years of athletic training work experience (recommended)
- Submit three letters of recommendation (at least one from a supervising athletic trainer or other healthcare professional)
- Submit resume or curriculum vitae
- Submit a statement of professional and personal goals to include your reasoning for completing the FIU DAT

+ Athletic Trainers who possess a Bachelor's degree as their highest degree may inquire about admissions into the DAT program by contacting the program director at jkonin@fiu.edu.
