Nurse Anesthesiology



The DNP Anesthesiology Nursing Program is a clinical specialty track within the Doctor of Nursing Practice (DNP) program of the Graduate Nursing Department at Florida International University Nicole Wertheim College of Nursing & Health Sciences. It is a challenging and rewarding academic and clinical undertaking consisting of 36 months, nine (9) semester continuous program of full-time graduate study.

Upon completion of the program, graduates will be eligible to take the National Certification Examination to become a Certified Registered Nurse Anesthetist (CRNA) as well as apply for the Advanced Practice Registered Nurse (APRN) credential with a specialization as a Nurse Anesthetist.

Admissions Minimum Requirements

- A Bachelor of Science in Nursing (BSN) degree from an accredited institution
- A current unrestricted Registered Nurse (RN) license
- A minimum of one (1) year current full-time experience as an RN in the United States as a critical care setting (ICU units only) at the time of application deadline
- A minimum GPA of 3.0 (in the last 60 credits of undergraduate upper division course work)
- Admission to the FIU Graduate School
- ACLS, PALS and CPR certification prior to enrollment and will remain current through the third semester
- CCRN certification

How to Apply:

- 1 **Submit online NursingCAS Application (Service fee.)**
 - Refer to direct link in the DNP Anesthesiology Nursing Program website.
 - Submit Official Transcripts to NursingCAS from ALL SCHOOLS attended for college credit (AA, BSN, Masters, Doctoral Degrees) for upload, verification, Science Grade Point Average (SGPA) and GPA calculations
 - Upload all required supplemental items:
 - Three (3) professional reference letters
 - CCRN Certificate and Score Report
 - Professional Curriculum Vitae/CV
 - Active and unrestricted RN license
 - Personal Statement
- 2 **Submit online FIU Supplemental Application (Service fee.)**
 - Refer to direct link in the DNP Anesthesiology Nursing Program website.
- 3 **Professional Interview with the DNP Anesthesiology Nursing Admissions Committee: Following a review, a select number of applicants will participate in a panel interview by invitation ONLY**
