Online MHSA

Offered solely through the FIU ONLINE platform and designed with the working professional in mind, the online MHSA reflects the highly technological environment associated with the field.

Fast-Track Hybrid

We designed our Fast-Track 18-months program for students to master the combination of technological and management skills with interpersonal collaborations that define health management at the highest levels. Each course is evenly split between online content delivered through FIU Online and oncampus classroom learning.

Admissions Minimum Requirements

- A bachelor's degree from regionally accredited institution.
- A minimum 3.0 GPA in last 60 credits (upper division).
- Meet FIU general graduate admissions requirements.
- Demonstrate English Proficiency (if degree is from an international university) by the FIU requirements
 - o Ex: iBT TOEFL: 80
 - Paper TOEFL 550/IELTS: 6.5
- · Submit a one-page personal statement (e.g. describe your career goals, why you want to pursue this degree, etc.)

How to Apply:

- Online graduate application and \$30 (USD) nonrefundable fees.
 - A minimum 3.0 GPA in the last 60 credits of upperlevel undergraduate coursework.
 - Personal statement.
 - Official transcripts from all colleges/universities previously attended (undergraduate and graduate). Transcripts must be sent to FIU directly by the institution(s) in electronic format or mailed in a sealed institution envelope.

International Students

- · Proof of degree
- Official TOEFL/IELTS scores Meeting the minimum requirements does not guarantee admission into the program.

Applications missing the departmental application will not be reviewed.
