The Nurse Educator MSN provides a unique combination of courses to prepare the graduate in the pedagogical competencies essential to teach nursing in an increasingly complex health care environment. The technologically enhanced plan of study builds on advanced professional nursing competencies and emphasizes the use of a variety of assessment, instructional, curricular development, and evaluative strategies that facilitate learning in culturally diverse populations.

Graduates are prepared to function in a variety of educational settings including schools of nursing and health care facilities. Graduates are qualified to sit for the NLN's Certification for Nurse Educators (CNE).

Admissions Minimum Requirements

- BSN from an ACEN or CCNE accredited program. Applicants from programs without such accreditation will be considered on an individual basis
- Cumulative undergraduate GPA of 3.0 or greater on a 4.0 scale (CUM GPA is a calculation inclusive of all academic coursework taken for college credit)
- UG 60 GPA of 3.0 or greater in Bachelor of Nursing upper division coursework
- Current State of Florida RN license, Out-of-state students must obtain a license to practice in Florida prior to admission
- Demonstrate English Proficiency (ONLY Graduates of non-English speaking institutions) by the FIU requirements Ex:
 - o iBT TOEFL: 80
 - Paper TOEFL 550/IELTS: 6.5

If selected for admission and prior to enrollment, candidate must provide documentation of NWCNHS-required criminal background investigation, drug screening, etc.

How to Apply:

- Submit online application via NursingCAS http:// www.nursingcas.org by deadline (Service fee.)
 - Submit official Transcripts to NursingCAS from ALL SCHOOLS attended for college credit (AA, BSN Degrees) for upload, verification and GPA calculations
 - Upload all required supplemental items:
 - Three (3) professional reference letters
 - Professional Curriculum Vitae/CV
 - Active Florida RN License
 - Personal Statement
- Submit FIU Supplemental Application (Service fee.)
 - Send Official Transcripts from all all colleges and universities attended (ASN, AA, BSN, etc.) to FIU Office of Graduate Admissions
 - FIU graduate admissions requirements apply https://admissions.fiu.edu
